

Unitor8 Control Version 3.1 for Mac OS X

Unitor8 Control is now available as version 3.1 for Mac OS X 10.2 or higher. It allows you to edit the advanced settings of the MIDI interfaces Unitor8 (synchronization, patch mode) and AMT8 (patch mode).

Unitor8 Control is not required for the "usual" 8-port MIDI interface operation.

Please note

- The MIDI interface MT4 is not supported (because it must be set up via MIDI port "all", which is currently not supported in Mac OS X).
- OMS is not supported because there is no OMS version available for Mac OS X. Instead, Unitor8 Control for Mac OS X uses Core MIDI for MIDI communication (like all Mac OS X applications).
- There is no support of serial ports ("Modem" or "Printer") in Mac OS X. However, even older Unitor8 without USB can be fully edited if they are connected to an Unitor8/AMT8 which is connected to the computer via USB.
- There is currently a maximum of one cascade consisting of up to 8 devices.
